1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill Nos. 411 & 230, Page 4, Section 160.771, Lines 7-23, by deleting all of the said lines
3 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 "(3) "Crime", the crimes listed in section 160.261.

6 3. Beginning in the 2024 -25 school year, every public school district and charter school's
7 antibullying policy, required under section 160.775, shall include a statement that requires the
8 administration, when determining disciplinary action for a pupil who has committed an act of school
9 violence or exhibited violent behavior, to take into account if such act of school violence or violent
10 behavior was committed in self-defense as an immediate response to an act of school violence or
11 violent behavior committed against such pupil.

12 4. (1) Any school district employee or volunteer may, in the course of fulfilling duties or
13 performing services for such school district, intervene in an incident involving an act of school
14 violence, violent behavior, or crime committed against a pupil who is a victim of bullying to protect
15 such pupil.

16 (2) Any such school district employee or volunteer shall be held harmless and immune from any
17 liability for actions described in subdivision (1) of this subsection if:

18 (a) In the course of intervening in such incident, such employee or volunteer follows a proper
19 procedure for such interventions adopted by the school board of such school district; or

20 (b) Such employee or volunteer intervenes in good faith and in a manner that such employee or
21 volunteer reasonably believes is afforded the defense of justification under chapter 563."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
24 accordingly.
