1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 1108 & 1181, Page 32, Section 570.212,
2 Line 11, by inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "571.060. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful transfer of weapons if he or she:

5 (1) Knowingly sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers a firearm or ammunition for a
6 firearm to any person who, under the provisions of section 571.070, is not lawfully entitled to
7 possess such;

8 (2) Knowingly sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers a blackjack to a person less than
9 eighteen years old without the consent of the child's custodial parent or guardian, or recklessly, as
10 defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers any firearm to a person less
11 than eighteen years old without the consent of the child's custodial parent or guardian; provided, that
12 this does not prohibit the delivery of such weapons to any peace officer or member of the United
13 States Armed Forces or National Guard while performing his or her official duty; [or]

14 (3) Recklessly, as defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, loans, gives away or delivers a
15 firearm or ammunition for a firearm to a person who is intoxicated; or

16 (4) Knowingly, in a commercial transaction, sells, leases, loans, or trades a fully automatic
17 firearm or semi-automatic firearm to any person under twenty years of age, provided that this does
18 not prohibit the delivery of such weapons to any peace officer or member of the United States
19 Armed Forces or National Guard while performing his or her official duty.

20 2. A person commits the offense of unlawful transfer of weapons if he or she is under
21 twenty years of age and knowingly, in a commercial transaction, buys, trades, or leases a fully
22 automatic firearm or semi-automatic firearm, provided that this does not prohibit the acceptance of
23 such weapons by any peace officer or member of the United States Armed Forces or National Guard
24 while performing his or her official duty.

25 3. For purposes of this section, a "semi-automatic firearm" means any repeating firearm
26 whose action mechanism automatically loads ammunition into the chamber and prepares it for
27 subsequent firing but requires a shooter to manually discharge each shot. The term shall include any
28 firearm in which actuating the trigger or hammer rotates a new chamber in line with the barrel.

1 4. Unlawful transfer of weapons under subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section is a
2 class E felony; unlawful transfer of weapons under [~~subdivisions~~] subdivision (2) [and], (3), or (4)
3 of subsection 1 of this section or under subsection 2 of this section is a class A misdemeanor."; and

5 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
6 accordingly.
