FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight assumes Section 329.280 allows any cosmetologist holding a current and active license to register with the board for a "personal service registration", along with submitting an application and a fee (set by the board). Section 329.280 does not specify the fee amount, however, Oversight assumes the revenue generated by this legislation will be minimal. For fiscal note purposes, Oversight will reflect an "Unknown, less than \$100,000" revenue into the Cosmetology and Barber Exam Fund (0785).

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules** assume this proposal is not anticipated to cause a fiscal impact beyond its current appropriation.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** note many bills considered by the General Assembly include provisions allowing or requiring agencies to submit rules and regulations to implement the act. The SOS is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of normal activity resulting from each year's legislative session. The fiscal impact for this fiscal note to the SOS for Administrative Rules is less than \$5,000. The SOS recognizes that this is a small amount and does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the office can sustain with its core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the cost of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the governor.

FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

Licensed cosmetologist and/or a licensed cosmetology establishment could be impacted by this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill specifies that, any cosmetologist holding a license to practice certain categories of cosmetology, as described in the bill, may register with the State Board of Cosmetology and Barber Examiners for a personal service registration to provide services to clients who are ill, disabled, or otherwise unable to travel to a cosmetology establishment. An applicant for a personal service registration shall submit to the Board an application, the fee set by the Board, and a copy of the applicant's license. An applicant for a personal service registration may be denied if the applicant has pled guilty or been found guilty of any of the offenses set forth in the bill.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
