## **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this agency.

**Oversight** assumes there could be savings for school districts if annual training is no longer required and districts choose a training schedule other than annually (based on the needs of the school district, each individual employee, or both). Oversight assumes new training, instruction or education required under state law or rules promulgated by DESE must occur for three consecutive beginning in FY 2025 for each employee before annual training is no longer required.

**Oversight** did not receive any responses from school districts related to the fiscal impact of this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.
