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### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA)** assume this legislation would require the Director of the Missouri Department of Agriculture to travel a 300 mile round trip (MDA office to Kansas City, MO) for 12 meetings. Fiscal impact would include mileage (\$0.55 per mile) and a \$48 meal per diem per day. MDA would incur a total fiscal impact of \$2,556 in FY 2024, \$2,607 in FY 2025 and \$2,659 in FY 2026 to implement the changes in this proposal.

**Oversight** notes the new council will consist of 34 members, meets monthly and the members will be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses. Oversight assumes this proposal will require roughly \$50,000 in expense reimbursement to the 34 members for 12 meetings (34 members x 12 meetings per year x \$122 in expenses (mileage, meals, etc.)). Oversight will reflect the cost to various state funds.

Officials from the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety – Directors Office and the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration and the University of Missouri each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

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#### FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill codifies the "Missouri Geospatial Advisory Council", within the Office of Administration. The council shall consist of 34 members, the makeup of which is provided in the bill. Additional subject matter experts may participate in activities as non-council members. Members of the council shall serve three year terms without compensation.

The council shall meet monthly and as otherwise required. It may apply for federal and state grants to sponsor and publish surveys and to solicit or develop proposals for projects related to state geospatial data infrastructure.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
