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#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Sections 407.2030 – Motor Vehicle Financial Protection Products

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

**Oversight** notes provisions of section 407.2080 impose a penalty of not more than \$500 for each violation and not more than \$10,000 in the aggregate for all violations of a similar nature. Oversight notes that violations resulting in fines could vary widely from year to year. Civil penalties collected per Article IX, Section 7 of the Missouri Constitution requires fines to be distributed to the school district where the violation occurred; therefore, Oversight will reflect a positive fiscal impact of \$0 to Unknown to local school districts on the fiscal note.

#### House Amendment 1

**Oversight** notes the definition change of "Debt Waiver" in House Amendment 1 has changed the fiscal impact from the House Committee Substitute to zero impact to the Insurance Dedicated Fund.
