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### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§§43.539 and 43.540 – Missouri Rap Back Program

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Public Safety – (Missouri Highway Patrol, Office of the Director, State Emergency Management Agency and Missouri Veterans Commission), the Department of Revenue, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Missouri Lottery Commission, the Missouri National Guard, the Office of Administration, the Office of the State Auditor, the St. Louis County Police Department, and the Phelps County Sheriff's Department assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Gaming Commission, the Department of Social Services, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Branson Police Department, the Kansas City Police Department, and the St. Joseph Police Department assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to similar legislation from 2023 (HB 70), the **Missouri Highway Patrol** stated, upon further inquiry, the impact to the Criminal Record System fund is unknown. Oversight assumes removing the "within the previous six years" from section in the bill, may result in a reduction in fees paid to the Criminal Records Systems Fund.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in the MOLIS database is available upon request.

## FISCAL DESCRIPTION

#### RAP BACK (Sections 43.539 and 43.540)

Currently, qualified entities receive Rap Back notifications for individuals as long as the individual has had a Missouri and national criminal record review completed within the previous six years. This bill eliminates the six-year limitation such that a qualified entity will continue to receive Rap Back notifications for individuals as long as the individuals have at some point had a Missouri and national criminal record review completed.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
