## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

#### <u>§44.087 – Assistance from Another Jurisdiction of Law Enforcement</u>

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Phelps County Sheriff's Office**, the **Branson Police Department**, the **Kansas City Police Department** and the **St. Joseph Police Department** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

#### §§300.100 & 304.022 – Siren Use for Emergency Vehicles

In response to similar legislation from this year, HB 942, officials from the **Phelps County Sheriff** and the **Kansas City Police Department** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

#### Bill as a Whole

Officials from the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Department of Revenue, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Missouri Department of Transportation and the St. Louis County Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local law enforcement were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
