AN ACT

To appropriate money for the expenses, grants, refunds, and distributions of the Department of Public Safety and Department of National Guard and the several divisions and programs thereof to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, and to transfer money among certain funds for the period beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

- There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in 2 Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the purpose of funding each
- 3 department, division, agency, fund transfer, and program described herein for the item or items
- 4 stated, and for no other purpose whatsoever, chargeable to the fund designated, for the period
- 5 beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, as follows:

PART 1

14	guidance to the Department of Public Safety in implementing the
15	appropriations found in Part 1 and Part 2 of this act. An
16	appropriation may be comprised in whole or in part of a one-time
17	amount, and such one-time amount shall be construed to be a
18	component part of, and not in addition to, the stated appropriation
19	amount. Any amount of an appropriation identified as "one-time"
20	in this act shall not be considered an addition to any ongoing core
21	appropriation(s) in future fiscal periods beyond June 30, 2024.
