AN ACT

To repeal section 226.1150, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the German heritage corridor of Missouri.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 226.1150, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 226.1150, to read as follows:

226.1150. The counties located along the Missouri River that were greatly influenced

- 2 by early German settlers including Boone, Chariton, Saline, Lafayette, Cooper, Howard,
- 3 Moniteau, Cole, Callaway, Osage, Gasconade, Montgomery, Warren, Franklin, St. Charles,
- 4 [and] St. Louis, and Perry, and the City of St. Louis, shall be designated the "German
- 5 Heritage Corridor of Missouri". The department of transportation may place suitable
- 6 markings and informational signs in the designated areas. Costs for such designation shall be
- 7 paid by private donations.
