AN ACT

To repeal section 430.080, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to a lien on chattel.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 430.080, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 430.080, to read as follows:

430.080. Every person expending labor, services, skill or material upon any chattel at the request of its owner, authorized agent of the owner, or lawful possessor thereof, in the amount of ~~twenty-five~~ **ten thousand** dollars or less, shall have a lien upon such chattel beginning upon the date of commencement of such expenditure of labor, services, skill, or materials for the contract price for all such expenditure of labor, services, skill, or material, until the possession of such chattel is voluntarily relinquished to such owner or authorized agent, or to one entitled to the possession thereof. **Enforcement of the lien may be by sale as provided under section 430.090.**
