## AN ACT

To amend chapters 226 and 252, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to the disposal of dead animals from roadways.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 226 and 252, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto two new 2 sections, to be known as sections 226.940 and 252.031, to read as follows:

226.940. The department of transportation shall remove and bury any dead deer found on a road or highway, or found on a shoulder or right-of-way, that is large enough to impede traffic. Such burial shall be made on department of conservation land at a minimum depth of three feet with the costs paid as provided under section 252.031.

252.031. The department of conservation shall reimburse the department of transportation for the costs associated with the removal and burial of dead deer from the roads, highways, shoulders, or right-of-way of this state, as required under section 226.940.
