## AN ACT

To amend chapter 217, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the provision of nutraloaf in correctional centers.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 217, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 217.153, to read as follows:

217.153. **Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a correctional center shall not  
2 use nutraloaf, prison loaf, or other form of bread as a disciplinary tool. For purposes of  
3 this section, "nutraloaf" or "prison loaf" means a food product made from various  
4 ingredients mixed together, baked in a loaf, and served to offenders who have  
5 misbehaved instead of normal meals.**
