AN ACT

To amend chapter 476, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the removal of certain court records from automated case management systems.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 476, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 476.1025, to read as follows:

3 **476.1025. A parent, spouse, child, or personal representative of a person who**
4 **was convicted of a misdemeanor offense may petition the court in which the person was**
5 **convicted to have the record of such offense removed from any automated case**
6 **management system if such person has been deceased for six months or more. Such**
7 **petition shall be accompanied by a copy of the death certificate of the deceased person.**
8 **Prior to such removal, the court shall determine whether any person would be unfairly**
9 **prejudiced by having such record removed from the automated case management**
10 **system.**

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets **[thus]** in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
