1 **WHEREAS**, Roy Blunt served as a United States Senator for Missouri from January
2 2011 to January 2023; and

4 **WHEREAS**, as a United States Senator for Missouri, Roy Blunt voted for the Bipartisan
5 Safer Communities Act, which infringes on the Second Amendment right to keep and bear arms
6 by implementing procedures for gun confiscation; and

7

8 **WHEREAS**, as a United States Senator for Missouri, Roy Blunt voted for the Respect
9 for Marriage Act, which violates the First Amendment right to religious freedom; and

10

11 **WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the Respect for Marriage Act, religious schools,
12 faith-based organizations, and other nonprofit entities are at risk of losing tax-exempt status and
13 access to a wide array of federal programs based solely on their views of marriage; and

14

15 **WHEREAS**, despite marriage being regulated by the states and never mentioned in the
16 United States Constitution, the Respect for Marriage Act forces states to recognize marriages
17 performed by other states, in violation of the Tenth Amendment; and

19 **WHEREAS**, as a United States Senator for Missouri, Roy Blunt voted for hundreds of
20 billions of dollars in wasteful spending, including the pork-laden Infrastructure Investment and
21 Jobs Act and legislation that sent Ukraine billions of taxpayer dollars with negligible oversight
22 of the use of the funds:

24 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri House

25 of Representatives, One Hundred Second General Assembly, First Regular Session, hereby
26 remonstrate against Roy Blunt for his votes as a United States Senator for Missouri in favor of
27 the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act, the Respect for Marriage Act, and legislation that
28 included hundreds of billions of dollars in wasteful spending.
