	WHEREAS, Roy Blunt served as a United States Senator for Missouri from January
2	2011 to January 2023; and

4 5	WHEREAS, as a United States Senator for Missouri, Roy Blunt voted for the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act, which infringes on the Second Amendment right to keep and bear arms
6 7	by implementing procedures for gun confiscation; and
8 9	WHEREAS, as a United States Senator for Missouri, Roy Blunt voted for the Respect for Marriage Act, which violates the First Amendment right to religious freedom; and

11 12 13	WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Respect for Marriage Act, religious schools, faith-based organizations, and other nonprofit entities are at risk of losing tax-exempt status and access to a wide array of federal programs based solely on their views of marriage; and

15 16 17	WHEREAS, despite marriage being regulated by the states and never mentioned in the United States Constitution, the Respect for Marriage Act forces states to recognize marriages performed by other states, in violation of the Tenth Amendment; and

19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, as a United States Senator for Missouri, Roy Blunt voted for hundreds of billions of dollars in wasteful spending, including the pork-laden Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act and legislation that sent Ukraine billions of taxpayer dollars with negligible oversight of the use of the funds:
