AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to patient examinations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 191.240, to read as follows:

191.240. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "patient examination" means any pelvic, prostate, or rectal examination.

- 2. A health care provider shall not knowingly perform a patient examination on a patient who is anesthetized or unconscious in a health care facility unless:
- (1) The patient or a person authorized to make health care decisions for the patient has given specific informed consent to the patient examination;
- 7 (2) The patient examination is necessary for diagnostic or treatment purposes; 8 or
 - (3) A court orders the performance of the patient examination for the collection of evidence.
- 3. A health care provider who violates subsection 2 of this section is subject to discipline by any licensing board that licenses the health care provider.

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
