AN ACT

To amend chapter 160, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to panic alert systems in schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 160, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 160.669, to read as follows:

**160.669. 1. Each school district in the following cities and counties shall install a
2 panic alert system as provided in this section:**

3 **(1) Any city not within a county; and**

4 **(2) Any county with more than one million inhabitants.**

5 **2. Each school district in any city or county listed in subsection 1 of this section
6 shall require the installation of a panic alert system in locations to be determined by
7 such school district. Such panic alert system shall integrate with local emergency
8 communications systems and be capable of connecting diverse emergency services
9 technologies to ensure real-time coordination between multiple first responder and law
10 enforcement agencies.**

11 **3. Each school district in any city or county listed in subsection 1 of this section
12 shall implement such system before July 1, 2024.**
