AN ACT

To amend chapter 197, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to emergency contraception.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 197, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 197.137, to read as follows:

197.137. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

- 2 (1) "Emergency contraception", any drug or device approved by the Food and 3 Drug Administration that prevents pregnancy after sexual intercourse;
- 4 (2) "Sexual assault", the same meaning given to the term in section 455.010.
- 5 2. Each hospital licensed under this chapter shall offer emergency contraception
- 6 to any woman who presents herself for care at the hospital and reports to the hospital
- 7 that a sexual assault was committed against her within the previous five days.
