AN ACT

To repeal section 302.177, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to drivers' licenses.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 302.177, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 302.177, to read as follows:

302.177. 1. To all applicants for a license or renewal to transport persons or property classified in section 302.015 who are at least twenty-one years of age ~~and under the age of seventy;~~ and who submit a satisfactory application and meet the requirements of sections 302.010 to 302.605, the director shall issue or renew such license; except that no license shall be issued if an applicant's license is currently suspended, cancelled, revoked, disqualified, or deposited in lieu of bail. Such license shall expire on the applicant's birthday in the sixth year of issuance, unless the license must be issued for a shorter period due to other requirements of law or for transition or staggering of work as determined by the director. The license must be renewed on or before the date of expiration, which date shall be shown on the license.

2. To all applicants for a license or renewal to transport persons or property classified in section 302.015 who are less than twenty-one years of age ~~or greater than sixty-nine years of age;~~ and who submit a satisfactory application and meet the requirements of sections 302.010 to 302.605, the director shall issue or renew such license; except that no license shall be issued if an applicant's license is currently suspended, cancelled, revoked, disqualified, or deposited in lieu of bail. Such license shall expire on the applicant's birthday in the third year of issuance, unless the license must be issued for a shorter period due to other requirements of law or for transition or staggering of work as determined by the director. 18 renewed on or before the date of expiration, which date shall be shown on the license. [A
19 license issued under this section to an applicant who is over the age of sixty-nine and contains
20 a school bus endorsement shall not be issued for a period that exceeds one year.]

21 3. To all other applicants for a license or renewal of a license who are at least twenty-
22 one years of age [and under the age of seventy,] and who submit a satisfactory application and
23 meet the requirements of sections 302.010 to 302.605, the director shall issue or renew such
24 license; except that no license shall be issued if an applicant's license is currently suspended,
25 cancelled, revoked, disqualified, or deposited in lieu of bail. Such license shall expire on the
26 applicant's birthday in the sixth year of issuance, unless the license must be issued for a
27 shorter period due to other requirements of law or for transition or staggering of work as
28 determined by the director. The license must be renewed on or before the date of expiration,
29 which date shall be shown on the license.

30 4. To all other applicants for a license or renewal of a license who are less than
31 twenty-one years of age [or greater than sixty-nine years of age,] and who submit a
32 satisfactory application and meet the requirements of sections 302.010 to 302.605, the
33 director shall issue or renew such license; except that no license shall be issued if an
34 applicant's license is currently suspended, cancelled, revoked, disqualified, or deposited in
35 lieu of bail. Such license shall expire on the applicant's birthday in the third year of issuance,
36 unless the license must be issued for a shorter period due to other requirements of law or for
37 transition or staggering of work as determined by the director. The license must be renewed
38 on or before the date of expiration, which date shall be shown on the license.

39 5. The fee for a license issued for a period which exceeds three years under
40 subsection 1 of this section shall be thirty dollars.

41 6. The fee for a license issued for a period of three years or less under subsection 2 of
42 this section shall be fifteen dollars, except that the fee for a license issued for one year or less
43 which contains a school bus endorsement shall be five dollars[, except renewal fees shall be
44 waived for applicants seventy years of age or older seeking school bus endorsements].

45 7. The fee for a license issued for a period which exceeds three years under
46 subsection 3 of this section shall be fifteen dollars.

47 8. The fee for a license issued for a period of three years or less under subsection 4 of
48 this section shall be seven dollars and fifty cents.

49 9. Beginning July 1, 2005, the director shall not issue a driver's license for a period
50 that exceeds an applicant's lawful presence in the United States. The director may establish
51 procedures to verify the lawful presence of the applicant and establish the duration of any
52 driver's license issued under this section.

53 10. The director of revenue may adopt any rules and regulations necessary to carry
54 out the provisions of this section. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated pursuant to the

55 authority of this section shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to the
56 provisions of chapter 536.
