AN ACT

To amend chapter 162, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to carbon monoxide detectors in schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 162, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 162.1201, to read as follows:

**162.1201. 1. Before July 1, 2024, the local board of education of each school
2 district shall adopt a written policy that promotes awareness of the dangers of carbon
3 monoxide poisoning and requires the administration of each public school building
4 within the district to conduct an annual evaluation of each public school building over
5 which such administration has control to determine the presence of, the need for, and
6 the future placement of carbon monoxide detectors in such buildings.**

**7 2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall develop a model
8 policy that satisfies the requirements of subsection 1 of this section that districts may
9 adopt.**
