**AN ACT**

To amend chapter 195, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to marijuana facilities.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 195, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 195.780, to read as follows:

**195.780. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:**

2 **(1) "Contractor", a person who spends more than fourteen days per year**  
3 **performing work or service of any kind for a marijuana facility in accordance with a**  
4 **contract with that facility;**

5 **(2) "Department", the department of health and senior services;**

6 **(3) "Marijuana facility", an entity licensed or certified by the department of**  
7 **health and senior services to cultivate, manufacture, test, transport, dispense, or**  
8 **conduct research on marijuana or marijuana products;**

9 **(4) "Owner", an individual who has a financial or voting interest in ten percent**  
10 **or greater of a marijuana facility.**

11 **2. The department shall require all employees, contractors, owners, and**  
12 **volunteers of marijuana facilities to submit fingerprints to the Missouri state highway**  
13 **patrol for the purpose of conducting a state and federal fingerprint-based criminal**  
14 **background check.**

15 **3. The department may require that such fingerprint submissions be made as**  
16 **part of a marijuana facility application, a marijuana facility renewal application, and an**  
17 **individual's application for a license or permit authorizing that individual to be an**  
18 **employee, contractor, owner, or volunteer of a marijuana facility.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

19           **4. Fingerprint cards and any required fees shall be sent to the Missouri state**  
20 **highway patrol's central repository. The fingerprints shall be used for searching the**  
21 **state criminal records repository and shall also be forwarded to the Federal Bureau of**  
22 **Investigation for a federal criminal records search under section 43.540. The Missouri**  
23 **state highway patrol shall notify the department of any criminal history record**  
24 **information or lack of criminal history record information discovered on the individual.**  
25 **Notwithstanding the provisions of section 610.120 to the contrary, all records related to**  
26 **any criminal history information discovered shall be accessible and available to the**  
27 **department.**
