## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to Article X of the Constitution of Missouri, by adopting one new section relating to taxation.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next

- 2 following the first Monday in November, 2024, or at a special election to be called by the
- 3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
- 4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to Article X of the Constitution of the state of
- 5 Missouri:

- Section A. Article X, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adopting one new 2 section, to be known as Section 27, to read as follows:
  - Section 27. 1. For the purposes of this section, a "tax increase" is any increase in a tax rate or change in the person or items subject to tax without regard to any credits or deductions provided by state statute.
  - 2. No tax imposed by state statute or tax increase imposed by state statute shall go into effect or continue in effect if otherwise set to expire without prior approval at a statewide general election, as defined by state law.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of the constitution, no state funds shall be expended without first being appropriated by the legislature.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

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9 4. If any provision of this section conflicts with any other provision of the 10 constitution, the provisions of this section shall apply.

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
