AN ACT

To amend chapter 290, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to working hours for certain students.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 290, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 290.045, to read as follows:

**290.045. 1. A person who is sixteen years of age or older but under eighteen
2 years of age, enrolled in secondary school as a full-time student, and employed for wages
3 or other remuneration, shall not be permitted to work after 10:00 p.m. on an evening
4 before a school day when school is in session for the regular school year. The provisions
5 of this section may be waived by the director, in full or in part, depending upon the
6 nature of the employment. Such waiver shall be provided in writing to the employer by
7 the director. As used in this section, "director" means the director of the department of
8 labor and industrial relations or his or her authorized representative.**

9 **2. The provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall not include any person
10 employed by or working under the direct control of the person's parent or legal
11 guardian.**
