AN ACT

To amend chapter 160, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to driver education courses in public schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 160, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 160.079, to read as follows:

3 **160.079. The department of elementary and secondary education shall**
4 **promulgate all necessary rules and regulations to require all public high schools to**
5 **affix posters in visible locations in each high school to inform pupils about the**
6 **availability, location, and meeting time of driver education courses. Any rule or portion**
7 **of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority**
8 **delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to**
9 **all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and**
10 **chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly**
11 **pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul**
a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority
and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2023, shall be invalid and void.
