AN ACT

To amend chapter 105, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to annual leave for state employees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 105, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 105.940, to read as follows:

3 **105.940. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any state**
2 **employee who works ten-hour days and forty hours per week shall not be required to**
3 **take two hours of annual leave for paid holidays. Such employee shall have the option to**
4 **receive compensation only for an eight-hour work day for any paid holiday.**
