AN ACT

To amend chapter 105, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the anti-surveillance and foreign intervention act.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 105, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 105.1675, to read as follows:

**105.1675. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as "The Anti-
2 Surveillance and Foreign Intervention Act".**

**3 2. No elected or appointed member or employee of any state entity may use,
4 operate, or download on a state-owned device any social media application that is
5 owned, in whole or in part, by the Chinese government or any company that shares its
6 user's data with the Chinese Communist Party. This section shall not apply to military
7 or law enforcement agencies when doing so is in keeping with the fulfillment of their
8 duties.**
