8	terrorist ties and activity; and

10	WHEREAS, the border crisis is a homeland security concern and a threat to national
11	security; and

13	WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 4 of the United States Constitution states that "The
14	United States shall guarantee to every State in this Union a Republican Form of Government,
15	and shall protect each of them against Invasion"; and

17	WHEREAS, the Biden Administration has been derelict in this regard and in its duty
18	to address the crisis on our southern border:

24	Assistance Compact or other agreement with our sister states along our nation's southern
25	border to provide mutual aid, law enforcement resources, National Guard troops, or any
26	assistance Missouri can provide to assist in addressing the crisis; and
