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## AN ACT

To amend chapter 161, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the student-teacher collaboration advisory board.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 161, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 161.391, to read as follows:

**161.391. 1. There is hereby created the "Student-Teacher Collaboration Advisory Board", which shall consist of one deputy commissioner of education or such deputy's designee and one student and one teacher from each of the congressional districts in this state.**

**2. The commissioner of education shall annually appoint board members. Any student in grade eight or higher may be appointed to the board. Any teacher who has completed at least two full years of teaching in a classroom may be appointed to the board. The board shall meet once a year in a location of the commissioner's choosing. The commissioner shall select a chair from among the members of the board. No member shall be compensated for any service on the board or receive reimbursement for any travel to and from meetings.**

**3. The duties of the board shall include, but are not limited to, discussions of best practices in the classroom and programs, with an emphasis on curriculum and curriculum development in different regions throughout the state.**

**4. The board shall submit a report summarizing the meeting discussions to the governor and the general assembly after the conclusion of the annual meeting.**
