WHEREAS, the General Assembly has a tradition of granting the use of the House of 2 Representatives and Senate Chambers for mock legislative workshops conducted by civic organizations; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, TeenPact is a dynamic, hands-on leadership experience for Christian students, with a mission to train youth to understand the political process, value their liberty, 6 7 defend their Christian faith, and engage the culture: 8 9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, One Hundred Second General Assembly, hereby grant TeenPact 10 11 permission to use the House Chamber on Friday, March 31, 2023, from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 12 p.m. to conduct a mock legislative session; 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sponsor of this House Resolution, Representative Mitch Boggs, or his designee, shall be present in the House Chamber and shall 15 assume responsibility for the group's actions for the duration of the aforementioned event. 16 17 18 Special note: Participants in the aforementioned event shall conduct themselves in a manner 19 that preserves the dignity and honor of the House of Representatives. Such persons shall 20 behave respectfully and dress appropriately for the occasion. Food items, drinks, and smoking are prohibited on the floor of the House and lower gallery, and participants shall 21 22 refrain from any conduct that diminishes the decorum of the House Chamber. 23 Access to the dais is limited to the Speaker's podium for purposes of using the 24 microphone to speak to those assembled. Access to the staff area behind the rostrum is 25 prohibited. 26 Group photographs; the hanging of any banners or other items on the walls, curtains, or any surface within the House Chamber; and the use of any equipment, including 27 computers, phones, or other items on the dais and rostrum area, are also prohibited. 28 \checkmark
