

# HOUSE BILL NO. 1291

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### AN ACT

To amend chapter 210, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the summer camp safety task force.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 210, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 210.213, to read as follows:

- 210.213. 1. There is hereby created the "Summer Camp Safety Task Force".**
- 2. The members of the task force shall be as follows:**
- (1) The commissioner of the department of elementary and secondary education or his or her designee;**
  - (2) The director of the department of health and senior services or his or her designee;**
  - (3) Two members of the senate appointed by the president pro tempore and who serve on a health care-related committee. The two members shall be from different political parties;**
  - (4) Two members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and who serve on a health care-related committee. The two members shall be from different political parties;**
  - (5) A first responder as defined under section 192.2405;**
  - (6) A health care professional who specializes in pediatric care;**
  - (7) A representative of a for-profit summer camp;**
  - (8) A representative of a nonprofit summer camp;**
  - (9) Two summer camp safety advocates; and**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets ~~thus~~ in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

18           **(10) A representative from an insurance provider providing insurance to youth-**  
19 **serving organizations.**

20           **3. Members of the task force under subdivisions (5) to (10) of subsection 2 of this**  
21 **section shall be appointed by the commissioner of the department of elementary and**  
22 **secondary education.**

23           **4. Members of the task force shall serve without compensation, but the members**  
24 **shall receive reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending**  
25 **meetings of the task force.**

26           **5. The task force shall hold its first meeting within two months from August 28,**  
27 **2023. A majority of the task force shall constitute a quorum.**

28           **6. The duties of the task force shall be to:**

29           **(1) Determine the best and most effective way to license all Missouri summer**  
30 **camp;**

31           **(2) Require background checks for any person who is in contact with children**  
32 **attending a summer camp;**

33           **(3) Discuss training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external**  
34 **defibrillator and safety training for all staff members who are in contact with children**  
35 **attending a summer camp; and**

36           **(4) Create an emergency plan for all foreseeable situations that could place**  
37 **children at risk of harm or injury at a summer camp.**

38           **7. On or before August 28, 2025, the task force shall submit a report of its**  
39 **findings and recommendations to the general assembly.**

40           **8. This section shall expire on August 28, 2025, or at the conclusion of the task**  
41 **force's work, whichever is sooner.**

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
