1           **WHEREAS**, the state of Ohio is experiencing a significant environmental disaster;

4           **WHEREAS**, on February 3, 2023, a train carrying extremely hazardous chemicals,  
5 including phosgene and vinyl chloride, derailed and caught fire in East Palestine, Ohio; and

7           **WHEREAS**, in order to prevent an explosion, local authorities enacted a controlled  
8 release of toxic fumes; and

10           **WHEREAS**, the people of Ohio have experienced physical harm and significant  
11 economic impact, including massive loss of livestock and wildlife and contaminated lands  
12 and waterways:

14           **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri  
15 House of Representatives, One Hundred and Second General Assembly, First Regular  
16 Session, hereby offer our condolences and support to the people of the state of Ohio; and

18           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk be instructed to prepare a  
19 properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Mike DeWine, the governor of Ohio.
