

HB 95 -- MAIL THEFT

SPONSOR: Schwadron

This bill creates the offense of mail theft, which a person commits if he or she purposefully takes mail from another person's mailbox or premises without the consent of the addressee and with intent to deprive the addressee of the mail. The offense of mail theft is a class A misdemeanor for a first offense and a class E felony for a second or subsequent offense.

This bill is the same as HB 1637 (2022) and similar to HCS HB 825 (2021).
