

HB 218 -- REPORTING LOST OR STOLEN FIREARMS

SPONSOR: Weber

This bill requires a firearm owner to report to local law enforcement the loss or theft of a firearm within 72 hours of discovering the loss or theft. The local law enforcement agency shall enter the make, model, and serial number of the firearm into the Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System (MULES).

Failure to report a lost or stolen firearm is an infraction punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100 for the first violation, \$400 for the second violation, and a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 for the third violation or any subsequent violation.

This bill is the same as HB 1728 (2022).
