

HB 266 -- INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR IN VITRO FERTILIZATION

SPONSOR: Fogle

This bill requires health insurance companies to provide coverage for in vitro fertilization. Coverage required under this section shall include services and procedures performed at a medical facility licensed or certified by the Department of Health and Senior Services or another state health department that conform to the guidelines and minimum standards of the:

- (1) American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists for in vitro fertilization clinics; or
- (2) American Society for Reproductive Medicine for programs of in vitro fertilization.

The provisions of this bill won't apply to a supplemental insurance policy, including a life care contract, accident-only policy, specified disease policy, hospital policy providing a fixed daily benefit only, Medicare supplement policy, long term care policy, short-term major medical policy of six months' or less duration, or any other supplemental policy as determined by the Director of the Department of Commerce and Insurance.
