

HB 573 -- UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS

SPONSOR: Lavender

This bill requires the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations to waive the recovery of non-fraudulent overpayment of unemployment benefits that were directly funded by moneys from the state's Unemployment Compensation Fund, if the original claim was filed during a state of emergency declared by the Governor due to COVID-19, as well as funds originally distributed from the CARES Act or any other Coronavirus-related Federal legislation or program.

This bill contains an emergency clause.

This bill is the same as HB 2067 (2022)
