

HB 621 -- ORGAN DONATION

SPONSOR: Doll

This bill requires that a driver's license applicant indicate if they want to be excluded from the Organ Donor Registry at the time they submit the completed application for a driver's license to the Department of Revenue.

Currently, an applicant indicates if they want to be included. Under this bill, if the applicant indicates that they do not want to be excluded from the Registry, that will be considered consent for organ donation, for inclusion in the Organ Donor Registry, and for purposes of the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act.

The bill also clarifies that nothing in its provisions will be construed to abridge a person's right to abstain from participation in the Organ Donor Program.

This bill is similar to HB 2748 (2022).
