

HB 641 -- FIRE AND AMBULANCE DISTRICTS

SPONSOR: McGirl

The bill adds municipalities contracting for fire protection services to the list of political subdivisions authorized to impose, upon voter approval, a sales tax in an amount of up to 0.5% for fire protection services.

Current law authorizes ambulance and fire protection districts in certain counties to propose a sales tax at a rate of up to 0.5%. This bill allows such districts to propose a sales tax of up to 1.0%.

This bill is the same as HCS HB 2363 (2022).
