

HB 784 -- SCHOOL CALENDAR

SPONSOR: McMullen

Beginning with the 2024-25 school year in order for a school board to adopt a four-day school week for the upcoming school year, the board must adopt a resolution, which must include the reason for the change in number of days and demonstrate that a four-day school week is in the best interest for the pupils of the district.

Upon the board's adoption of the resolution the board shall notify the district's election authority and place the question of whether to adopt a four-day week on the next available municipal election. If the change to a four-day week is approved by the voters of the district the school board may implement a four-day school week calendar in the following year. If the voters reject such a change the district may not propose such a resolution for one year.

A school board that has adopted a four-day school week to begin in the 2024-25 school year must submit the question to the voters of the school district prior to implementing a four-day week.
