HB 804 -- SEXUAL CONTACT WITH A CHILD OR INCAPACITATED PERSON

SPONSOR: Ingle

This bill establishes the offense of sexual contact with a child or incapacitated person. A person is guilty of this offense if he or she has sexual contact with a child or incapacitated person and is a foster parent or legal guardian of the child or incapacitated person. The offense is a class E felony and does not allow the defense of consent to be invoked during prosecution.

This bill is the same as HB 2259 (2022).
