

HB 829 -- NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE ACT

SPONSOR: Mackey

This bill establishes the "Interstate Compact on the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote Act".

This Compact is made up of other states who have voluntarily adopted the language of this Act. The provisions of the agreement will only take effect when states cumulatively possessing a majority of the electoral college votes have joined the Compact.

After certification of a statewide vote for president, the chief election official shall determine which presidential candidate won the national popular vote. All of the electoral college votes of member states are pledged to that candidate.

Provisions are made for tie votes, as provided in the bill.

This bill is the same as HB 1945 (2022).
