

HB 955 -- VOTER REGISTRATION SOLICITATION

SPONSOR: Weber

Currently, no person other than a governmental entity may be compensated to solicit voter registration applications.

This bill repeals that prohibition, requiring any person soliciting voter registration applications to register with the Secretary of State if he or she is being paid to do so by an entity other than a governmental entity.

This bill also requires landlords to provide new lessees with voter registration applications provided by the local election authority of the county, and realtors to provide property purchasers with said applications.

This bill is similar to HB 2829 (2022).
