

HB 967 -- RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

SPONSOR: Davis

This bill repeals residency requirements for commissioned and civilian personnel of the St. Louis City police force and specifies that such personnel shall not be subject to a residency requirement of retaining a primary residence in the City of St. Louis but may be required to maintain a primary residence located within a one-hour response time.

The bill also repeals the provision allowing the Board of Police Commissioners to require law enforcement officers and other employees to reside within 30 miles from the nearest city limit and within the boundaries of the state of Missouri. Instead, the board may require that law enforcement officers or other employees to reside within a one-hour response time.
