

HB 1084 -- SUFFRAGE OF INDIVIDUALS CONFINED IN JAILS

SPONSOR: Bosley

This bill provides that any defendant confined in a jail and otherwise entitled to vote shall be afforded the opportunity to vote absentee from the jail. The jail shall be responsible for the costs of mailing the absentee ballot application. The local election authority shall provide the absentee ballot to any defendant confined in jail with postage-paid return envelopes. The jail shall mail the ballot back to the election authority before the deadline.

This bill is the same as HB 2363 (2020).
