

HB 1341 -- REPORTS OF COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL SAFETY CONCERNS

SPONSOR: Unsicker

This bill requires school districts, charter schools, or law enforcement agencies receiving a community or school safety concern submitted through a state reporting tool, such as the Courage2Report system or a succeeding one, to notify the State Highway Patrol how the entity received, responded to, and resolved the concern. This notification must be submitted within 15 calendar days of the receipt, unless the concern does not have a final resolution, in which case the notification shall be submitted every 30 calendar days after, until the final resolution of such concern. The bill specifies what must be described in the notification submitted to the State Highway Patrol.

Before February 1 of each year, the State Highway Patrol must create a list of each notification made in the previous calendar year, and submit said list to both chambers of the General Assembly. The bill specifies formatting and compiling requirements. No data related to the compilation shall be disclosed in any form so as to personally identify any person who has submitted a concern or any person involved in incidences causing a concern to be reported.
