HJR 2 -- INITIATIVE PETITIONS

SPONSOR: Billington

Currently, initiative petitions are required to receive signatures from 8% of the legal voters in two-thirds of the state's congressional districts in order to place a constitutional amendment on the ballot.

Upon voter approval, this resolution would require initiative petitions to receive signatures from 15% of the legal voters in two-thirds of the state's congressional districts in order to place a constitutional amendment on the ballot.

This bill does not affect signature requirements for initiative petitions proposing statutory changes.

This resolution is similar to HJR 65 (2022).
