

HJR 32 -- INITIATIVE PETITIONS

SPONSOR: Schnelting

Currently, amendments to the constitution and changes to statute that have been placed on the ballot require approval from a simple majority of the votes cast thereon in order to pass.

Upon voter approval, this resolution would require amendments to the constitution and changes to statute that have been placed on the ballot by initiative petition to receive approval from a number of votes greater than or equal to a majority of registered voters in order to pass.

This resolution would not affect measures referred to the people by the General Assembly.
