The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the Senate perfected version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the substantive provisions of this bill have already been approved by the House of Representatives. This bill provides for the collection of sales tax for motor vehicles at the point of sale. Recent technological advances now make the collection and reporting of this tax possible at the point of sale. This bill will prove hugely beneficial for the Missouri economy and state tax collection system.

Testifying in person for the bill were Senator Hough; and the MO Automobile Dealers Association.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
