

HCS SB 155 -- CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE ENTITIES

SPONSOR: Black

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on General Laws by a vote of 10 to 3. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Regulatory Oversight by a vote of 6 to 3.

This bill modifies provisions relating to certain administrative entities.

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the introduced version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill removes unnecessary requirements for membership on the State Fair Commission and allows for additional members from the district in which the State Fair is located. Further, the Joint Committee on Disaster Preparedness is made a permanent committee and the Housing Development Commission has appropriate legislative involvement by the appointment of additional members from the House of Representatives and the Senate.

Testifying in person for the bill was Senator Black.

OPPONENTS: There was not opposition voiced to the committee

Testifying in writing against the bill was Arnie C. Dienoff.
