HCS SS SB 181 -- CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS

SPONSOR: Crawford

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on Insurance Policy by a vote of 8 to 5. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules-Legislative Oversight by a vote of 7 to 3.

The testimony was based on the Senate perfected version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is needed protection for lenders. This bill also allows Missouri Employers Mutual to go private which would allow them to write policies for companies in multiple states and offer competitive rates.
